## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

State policy requires that students earn a minimum of 24 credits in grades 9–12. Seniors must meet the following requirements to graduate from a Polk County public high school:

1. Meet the course requirements outlined above.
2. Pass the High School Competency Test or Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test.
3. Achieve a 2.0 unweighted grade point average for grades 9–12.

## CURRICULUM

Lake Region High School is one of nine Polk District schools with a four period day curriculum. Students earn a full credit for each class successfully completed for a total of eight possible credits per year. Students have four ninety minute class periods, five days per week, eighteen weeks per term. Course credit is earned on a one credit per term basis.

Advanced Placement courses are offered in English, art, foreign language, science, social studies and math.

Honors, or College Preparatory courses, are offered in English, math, science, social studies, foreign languages, art, and music.

Additional programs available to the student body are college early admissions, dual enrollment, exceptional student education, technology education, and virtual school.

Ninth grade students are enrolled in the *Lake Region Freshmen Success Academy*.

### CLASS OF 2006

The class of 2006 sent approximately 70% of their graduates to either two (40%) or four (30%) year colleges and universities.

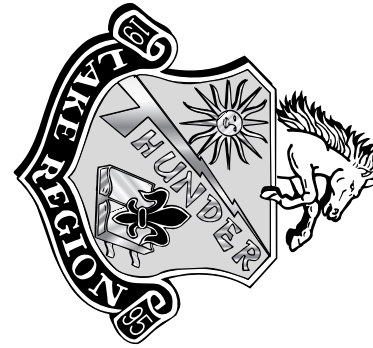
Central Polk County is located 45 miles southwest of Orlando and 50 miles east of Tampa.

## SCHOOL

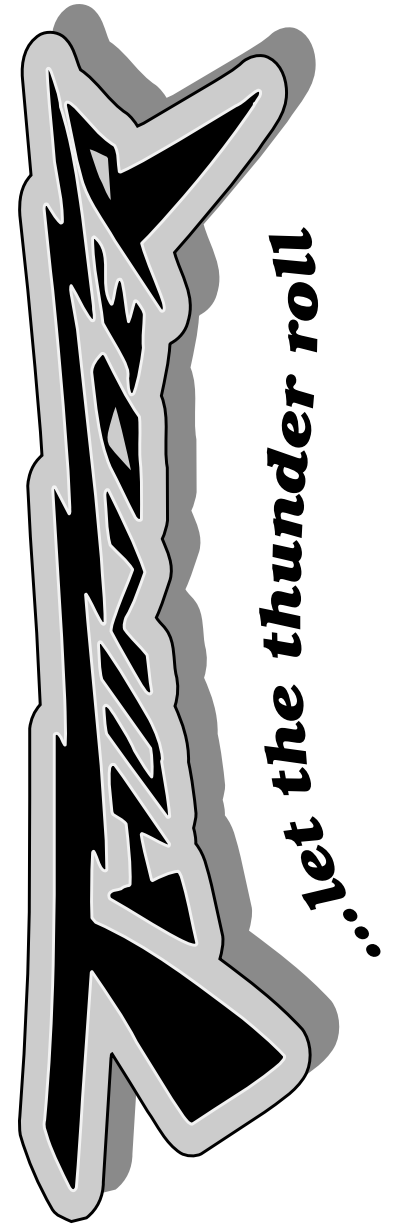
The high school serves grades 9–12. The enrollment is 2225. The senior class is 415 students.
