2018-2019 School Profile

Accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, Lake Region High School is one of 36 high schools located in Polk County, Florida. Lake Region High School was built in 1995 in Eagle Lake, Florida, and serves approximately 1500 students from the cities of Eagle Lake, Auburndale, Bartow, Eagle Lake, Lake Wales, Winter Haven and unincorporated Polk County.

The student population at Lake Region High School is culturally diverse. Seventy-seven percent of our students qualify for free or reduced lunch. Sixty seven percent of our students are minorities. AVID, Upward Bound, Title One, and Migrant Services are programs utilized at Lake Region High.

The school year consists of two semesters, each eighteen weeks long. The daily schedule consists of seven 50 minutes classes. Each student can earn seven credits per year/twenty-eight credits in four years. Twenty -four credits are required to graduate.

Students are afforded a wide range of both standard, honors, AP, and dual enrollment courses at Polk State College and Southeastern University. Lake Region offers six career academies: Culinary, Imagination, Inc., Construction, Law, Medical and Early Childhood.
