2017-18 Dress Code

Acceptable dress for students to wear for 2017-2018 school year.

1. Jeans, dress slacks, capris will be worn with appropriate fit.
2. Shorts, skirts/dresses, skorts will be closer to the knee with appropriate fit.
3. All shirts/dress tops will have sleeves.
4. All types of pants or shorts will be worn at or above the waist.
5. All shirts will have a neckline at neck/collar bone.
6. Pullover/hooded sweat shirts may be worn over appropriate clothing.

Unacceptable dress for students to wear for 2017-2018 school year.

1. Holes or frays above the knee in clothing
2. Clothing with inappropriate length
3. Skin exposed by midriff, side or back clothing
4. See through materials
5. Spandex, yoga pants, leggings, jeggings, or other spandex like material, sweatpants, pajama pants or athletic shorts (except for PE class)
6. Sweaters/jackets used to cover up inappropriate dress. The top/shirt itself must be appropriate.
7. Hats, bandanas/head coverings (without principal approval for religious/health/weather conditions)
8. Offensive, suggestive, indecent, or gang material on clothing
9. Bedroom slippers or heels over 2 inches

Notes:

*Academies may also have uniforms that are approved through administration: examples include nursing scrubs, JROTC attire, etc. *Any religious/special needs will be addressed on an individual basis by the principal. *Appropriate jackets will be accepted as weather warrants the need. All items of dress must meet the above guidelines, as well as the guidelines provided in the District Code of Conduct.
